#### **PARKING INSTRUCTIONS**

As a courtesy to the business owners in Jerome, we ask if possible, for you to park at the Jerome Public Parking Lot, behind the fire station off of Jerome-Perkinsville Rd. We will have transportation available for those who prefer not to walk.

Loading/Unloading/ACA parking: Located at the back of the Fire Station nearest to the beginning of the ramp walkway. The sign states "no parking", but this can be utilized as temporary parking for those who need it.
